followed by the Department of Development Services (15 students, 25.00 percent), Business Administration (7 students, 11.68 percent), Linguistics (5 students, 8.33 percent), Applied Thai Medicine (5 students, 8.33 percent), and the least majored in Public Health. 3 people, accounting for 5.00%.

Part 2 Typos/Thesis Formatting Problems.

Based on the analysis of the data on the types of problems and problems in the format of the thesis according to the reasons specified by the students in submitting the thesis for review, the Education Service Department has collected information on the contact for submission of the thesis book. It was found that the types of thesis formatting problems were 1) the page order number did not match between the table of contents and the book, with a deviation value of 3.21, and the standard deviation value was 0.31 at a moderate level, 2) the topic name did not match between the table of contents and the book. The standard deviation value is 1.95 at most levels. Consistent on every page. The standard deviation value is 0.07 at a high level. 5) Insertion of a, b, c, and Roman numerals from the Thai excerpt to the end before chapter 1 on the first page of every Thai/English abstract. The first page of every table of contents must not contain letters. 6) The use of macro (.), micro (.), colon (:), semicolon (;), and knocking after the symbol . ; ; ; 7) The main heading is level 1 subheading, and the subheading level 2.....3 It is not the same system consistently. There is a standard deviation value of 0.24 at least 8) Every new chapter is published. The first page must not chase the number in the order of the page. 9) The first page of a bibliography or reference document does not print the page sequence number, the standard deviation value is 2.14, and the standard deviation value is 1.23 at the least level.
